NOTICE TO TOWN OF NORWICH DOG OWNERS

DO YOU KNOW?

Did you know that New York State Law requires all dogs 4 months and older to be licensed? Licensing ensures that all dogs have been properly vaccinated against rabies for the protection of both you and your neighbors. The license also makes it easier to locate the owner of a lost dog when it is found. Any dog harbored at an address for more than 30 days must be licensed.

HOW DO I LICENSE MY DOG?

Licensing your dog is easy.

1. Simply come to the Norwich Town Hall, 157 County Road 32A, Norwich, NY, Monday –Friday from 10-2pm. 337-2301
2. Bring the current rabies certificate; please **do not** bring the rabies tag as proof.
3. A copy of spay/neuter certificate, if applicable
4. A check made out to Town of Norwich in the following amount: \$7.00
Spayed/neutered
\$14.00 not spayed or neutered
5. Every year we will mail you a renewal license for your convenience.
6. Any dog found to be unlicensed will be subject to an appearance ticket and \$25.00 fine.

The Dog Control Officer (DCO) is appointed by the Town to assist in the enforcement of NYS Dept. of Ag & Markets Article 7: Licensing, Identification and Control of Dogs and local laws. The DCO is authorized to serve appearance tickets when violations of Article 7 or local laws have been committed. Any person who observes a dog in violation of these laws may file a complaint with the DCO. Any dog running loose may be picked up by the DCO.

Local Law Number 1 of 2016

A local law to reduce the number of Elected Assessors in the Town of Norwich from Three to One

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Norwich as follows:

This local law is enacted pursuant to New York State Real Property Tax Law, Section 329.

The Town Board of the Town of Norwich, County of Chenango hereby finds and declares that the purpose of this local law is to reduce the number of elected assessors in the Town of Norwich from Three to One.

Effective on January 1,2017 the Town of Norwich shall have one elected Town Assessor.

This law shall not be subject to permissive or mandatory referendum.

This local law shall take effect on January 1,2017.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing upon said proposed ordinance will be held at the Town Hall,157 County Road 32A, Norwich, New York, on the 6th day of June, 2016, at 12:00 o'clock PM and that an opportunity to be heard in regard thereto will then and there be given to those favoring passage of such proposed ordinance and also to those opposed thereto.
