**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE TOWN BOARD  
OF THE TOWN OF NORWICH, NEW YORK  
TO CONSIDER ADOPTING A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW**

**Amendment**

Local Law Number 1 of 2018

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a local ordinance has been introduced in the Town Board of the Town of Norwich to regulate abandoned vehicles, junked vehicles and vehicles obstructing traffic in an emergency.

Said proposed ordinance in general terms states that a vehicle will be deemed to be **abandoned** if left unattended with no number plates for more than 6 hours on any highway or other public place; or for more than 24 hours on any highway or other public place; for more than 48 hours, after the parking of such vehicle shall have become illegal, if left on a portion of a highway or public place on which parking is legally permitted; for more than 96 hours on property of another if left without permission of the owner.

Any vehicle which is physically or legally incapable of being operated on a public street or highway shall be deemed a junk vehicle. A motor vehicle shall be presumed to be a junked vehicle if it is not duly registered and is dismantled or partly dismantled or dilapidated or is in a rusted or wrecked condition or lacks equipment in good operating condition necessary to enable it to be operated or required by law to enable it to be registered.

Said ordinance declares that a violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 and not more than \$1,000.00. A copy of said proposed ordinance is on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Authority to remove any motor vehicle that is abandoned or junked as defined herein may be taken into custody by the Highway Superintendent (after contacting Supervisor or a member of the Highway Committee) and shall be removed to such public or private storage garage as the Highway Superintendent shall determine.

The provision of this local law are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance.

This law shall not be subject to permissive or mandatory referendum,

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing upon said proposed ordinance will be held at the Town Hall, Norwich, New York on the 13th day of November, 2018, at 7:00PM and that an opportunity to be heard in regard thereto will then and there be given to those favoring passage of such proposed ordinance and also to those opposed thereto.

A copy of said proposed Local Law is on file at the Office of the Norwich Town Clerk, 157 County Road 32A, Norwich, New York, and is open for inspection during regular Office hours.
