Public Hearing Minutes for the Adoption of the Preliminary Budget of the Norwich Town Board held on Wednesday November 7, 2018 at the Town Hall.

Supervisor David Evans called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

A motion to open the Public Hearing was made by Council Member Milton Shepler; 2nd by Council Member Debra Cubbedge. All were in favor. The Public Hearing Notice was read by the Town Clerk. The Public Hearing Notice was placed in the Evening Sun newspaper, posted on the door at the Town Hall and on the Town website.

Hearing no comments from the public, Supervisor Evans declared the public hearing closed at 7:02 with a motion from Council Member Cubbedge; 2nd by Council Member Shepler. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Council Member Cubbedge; 2nd by Council Member Foulds to accept the budget as written. All were in favor.

Budget Officer Evans asked the board to add Joel Mathis, Smokin' Bones Restaurant, parcel ID#123.-1-6.72 to the tax re-levy in the amount of \$737.35 A motion to put the delinquent Water Sewer charges on the tax re-levy was made by Council Member Stanley Foulds; 2nd by Council Member Milton Shepler. All were in favor.

A motion to put the remainder of the Water Sewer from Parcel ID# 160.-1-13.6 in the amount of \$7544.62 was made by Council Member Stanley Foulds; 2nd by Council Member Debra Cuubedge. All were in favor.

► Highway Superintendent Christophersen submitted several photos of road pipes that are in desperate need of replacing along with a list of pipes on each town road.

► Also, submitted were estimates from Suit Kote for 2019 road repairs which included Sharman, Cooley Lake Road, and Aurora.

► Financing plan for the new truck is in progress

► A motion to purchase a plow for the red international truck in the cost of \$6675 was made by Council Member Brooks; 2nd by Council Member Foulds. All were in favor. The plow will not be in until January.

Budget Officer submitted his report for next meeting.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Council Member Stanley Foulds; 2nd by Council Member Charles Brooks. All were in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:35pm
